

Instructions for the shipment of samples

1. SUGGESTED TYPE OF CONTAINERS FOR SAMPLES

Sender must send the samples in sealed containers, unbreakable and suitable for various types of wastes, either solid, liquid, mud or debris. It is suggested to use the following containers:

• Liquids: 1 liter / 30 oz polyethylene bottle

Solids or semi-solids: 500 ml / 15 oz polyethylene wide-mouth jar

• Debris: 20" x 3" hi-density nylon bag with tie

Samples must be placed in a cardboard box for transportation.

2. LABELLING

The box must be labelled with the following information:

- Name and address of generator
- Description of waste
- Number of samples and individual weight
- Date
- Destination: Stablex Canada, c/o Nelie Nkwemi
